ORDER NO. R5-2007-0023

RESCINDING VARIOUS WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region, finds that the Board adopted the following Orders and Resolutions, which are no longer applicable for the reasons shown:

Order No. 76-249, adopted 17 December 1976, prescribes requirements for the discharge of wastewater from the Rio Bravo Park Resort at 11200 Lake Ming Road, Assessor's Number 386-020-07-00-0, which includes a portion of Section 4 T29S, R29E, MDB&M. The discharge was estimated at 6,000 gallons per day. In February 2006, the Resort was sold to CAVU Rock Prop Project 1 LLC, which reports that the Resort was leveled and that the WWTF no longer exists. (JEB)

Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. 2004-0067 (NPDES No. CA0084948), adopted 4 June 2004, prescribes requirements for the discharge of construction dewatering wastes from the Lower Northwest Interceptor (LNWI) construction project. All LNWI construction activities requiring dewatering are complete, and as of 27 October 2006, all dewatering facilities have been removed, dismantled and otherwise abandoned. By letter dated 8 February 2007, Sacramento Regional County Sanitation District requested termination of its NPDES permit for the LNWI construction project. The NPDES permit is no longer needed. (JDM)

Order No. 90-008 adopted on 26 January 1990, prescribes requirements for Deer Creek Ranch for discharge of wastewater from a recreational vehicle/tent camp facility to a mound disposal system. The facility was never constructed and the owner does not plan to build the approved facility in the future; the owner requested the order be rescinded.

Order No. 5-00-044, adopted 17 March 2000, prescribes requirements for the discharge to pastureland of wastewater by Nevada Titan Energy Incorporated from its Claflin, New Hope, Poso, and Enas-15 leases in the Poso Creek Oil Field. The leases lie within Sections 10, 11, 14 and 15, T27S, R27E, MDB&M. A letter dated 29 November 2006 from George Snider, Manager for Nevada Titan Energy, requested that the Regional Board rescind the waste discharge requirements. (JEB)

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above waste discharge requirements Orders and Resolutions are rescinded.
