ORDER NO. R5-2010-0112

RESCINDING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region, finds that the Board adopted the following Orders which are no longer applicable for the reasons shown:

Union Pacific Railroad Company, Dunsmuir Railyard discharges treated groundwater from a groundwater cleanup project at the Union Pacific Railroad Company's Dunsmuir Railyard. The treated groundwater is discharged to the Sacramento River, a water of the United States, in Dunsmuir, Siskiyou County. The discharge is currently regulated pursuant to Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) Order No. R5-2005-0016 (NPDES Permit No. CA0083178), however the discharge has now been enrolled for coverage under the general WDRs for Limited Threat Discharges of Treated/Untreated Groundwater from Cleanup Sites, Wastewater from Superchlorination Projects, and other Limited Threat Wastewaters to Surface Water (General Order) and assigned Enrollee Number R5-2008-0082-017. Therefore, it is appropriate to rescind the individual NPDES permit. Public notice regarding the proposed rescission was sent to the Discharger and interested parties, and no comments were received. (BJS)

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above Waste Discharge Orders are rescinded.
