**Project Description:**

The primary objective of the Solar Two Project and its ancillary facilities (Project) is to provide clean, renewable, solar-powered electricity and to assist San Diego Gas & Electric (SDG&E) in meeting its legislatively mandated obligations under California's Renewable Portfolio Standard (RPS) Program. A secondary goal is to assist SDG&E in reducing its greenhouse gas emissions as required by the California Global Warming Solutions Act. The Project is a solar power electric generation Project that has been developed and designed to conform to the requirements of the 20-year Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) between SDG&E and SES Solar Two, LLC (Solar Two or Applicant).
