NOTIFICATION OF WORK (September 2015) Property Topographical Surveys and Street Utility Marking Carousel Tract and Surrounding Area

Under the direction of the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board, consultants hired by Shell Oil Products US will be performing surveys and marking utilities in the Carousel neighborhood to support implementation of the approved Remedial Action Plan (RAP). Shell Oil Products US and its contractors will be contacting the owners and residents of each group of properties where work will take place ahead of time to answer questions and schedule this work.

Shell will use the survey data to prepare grading plans that will be submitted to the City of Carson and Los Angeles County Department of Public Works for approval and permitting. The survey data will also be used to develop your Property Specific Remediation Plan and as pre-construction inventory for proper site restoration.

WHAT: Survey crews from Dulin & Boynton will access all open areas of the front and back yards of the homes, including patios and driveways. The survey crew will survey and take photographs of features including fences, walls, patios, large trees, and other visible items.

WHEN: Beginning September 14, 2015, Monday through Friday, 7 A.M. to 5 P.M. Surveying will take approximately two to four hours per property.

Surveying work will be carried out over four years during the implementation of the RAP.

WHERE: The survey work will be completed in groups of approximately four to ten properties for each phase. Utility markings will be made on city streets throughout the Carousel Tract.

There will be no excavation or digging. The type of equipment that will be used is shown in the photograph. Surveying personnel will use vehicles with placards indicating the company name and will wear vests with name badges to identify them as a Dulin & Boynton survey crew. One or two trucks or vans will be used during the surveying work.
