CITY OF LOS ANGELES COMMENTS ON TENTATIVE RESOLUTION APPROVING TEMPORARY BYPASS OF DISINFECTED SECONDARY EFFLUENT TO THE 1-MILE OUTFALL DURING THE EFFLUENT PUMPING PLANT HEADER REPLACEMENT PROJECT – HYPERION TREATMENT PLANT (NPDES CA0109991, CI-1492)

On July 23, 2015, the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Board (Regional Water Board) released for public comments the Tentative Resolution approving the temporary bypass of disinfected secondary effluent to the 1-Mile Outfall during the Effluent Pumping Plant (EPP) Header Replacement Project. In response, the City of Los Angeles, Bureau of Sanitation (LASAN) appreciates the opportunity to comment on the tentative resolution.

On Section 2.e (Page 5) of the tentative resolution, the City is required to implement the extensive monitoring program (Monitoring Plan for HTP 1 Mile Diversion) developed by the City and approved by the Executive Officer of the Regional Water Board. This program includes monitoring that will be conducted before, during and after the 2015 EPP Project. After the release of the tentative resolution, the City submitted to the Regional Water Board on July 28, 2015 an updated and revised version of the Monitoring Plan, which will be utilized for the 2015 EPP Header Replacement Project. LASAN requests that the revised monitoring plan submitted on July 28, 2015 be the final Monitoring Plan for HTP 1 Mile Diversion referred to in the resolution.
