Background: The Regional Water Board developed and released a Draft Vineyard Order for public comment in June 2023. The Draft Vineyard Order requires farmers to address sediment in stormwater runoff from their vineyards. The Draft Vineyard Order also includes statewide rules that protect drinking water through domestic well testing and fertilizer management. To address concerns raised in public comment, Regional Water Board staff have developed a series of intended revisions that will be presented at this public meeting. The Vineyard Order is planned to be adopted in early 2025.
