## NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT

PROPOSED APPROVAL OF NON-REGULATORY AMENDMENTS TO ADMINISTRATIVELY UPDATE THE WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLAN FOR THE LOS ANGELES REGION (BASIN PLAN) THROUGH UPDATING CHAPTER 2 "BENEFICIAL USES" AND ADDING CHAPTER 7 "TOTAL MAXIMUM DAILY LOADS (TMDLs)"

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT** the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) will accept comments on the proposed approval of the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board's (Los Angeles Water Board) non-regulatory amendments that would administratively update the Basin Plan. The amendments include:

- (1) An administrative update to Chapter 2 "Beneficial Uses" which incorporates previously adopted language, updated maps, and corresponding beneficial use tables. This amendment to administratively update Chapter 2 "Beneficial Uses" was adopted by the Los Angeles Water Board on November 10, 2011. (Resolution R11-011)
- (2) The addition of Chapter 7 "Total Maximum Daily Loads," which incorporates previously adopted TMDLs. This amendment to administratively update the Basin Plan by adding Chapter 7 "Total Maximum Daily Loads" was adopted by the Los Angeles Water Board on December 8, 2011. (Resolution R11-013)

Comment letters **must be received by 12:00 noon on July 12, 2012.** Comment letters received after that deadline will not be accepted unless the State Water Board determines otherwise. **REQUIREMENTS FOR SUBMITTING COMMENTS** (23 Cal. Code Regs., § 3779, subd. (f)). The State Water Board may refuse to accept any comments that do not satisfy all of the following requirements:

- 1. Comments must specifically address the final version of the Basin Plan amendments adopted by the Los Angeles Water Board.
- If the Los Angeles Water Board previously responded to a similar or identical comment, the commenter must explain why and in what manner the commenter believes each of the responses provided by the Los Angeles Water Board to each comment was inadequate or incorrect.
- The commenter also must include either a statement that each of the comments was timely raised before the Los Angeles Water Board, or an explanation of why the commenter was unable to raise the specific comment before the Los Angeles Water Board.
