

I urge the State Water Resources Control Board to delay implementation or approval of copper TMDLs in any salt water bodies in California until a number of key actions occur such as allowing time for the USEPA to approve the Biotic Ligand Model (BLM) to determine copper toxicity in salt water. I urge the Board to reject the proposed amendment to the Los Angeles Regional Basin Pan to revise the Total Maximum Daily Loads for Marina del Rey Toxic Pollutants.

I further urge more complete scientific study of this issue, as I believe some assumptions are false.
