ADOPTING RESOLUTION NO. 67-30 AS WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLAN FOR
TIDAL WATERS INLAND FROM THE GOLDEN GATE AND WITHIN THE SAN
FRANCISCO BAY REGION

ADMINISTRATIVE INFORMATION

This Regional Board, on June 13, 1967, adopted Resolution No. 67-30 and related document as the "Water Quality Control Policy, Tidal Waters Inland From the Golden Gate and Within the San Francisco Bay Region."

A public hearing was held at Berkeley, California on February 26, 1970 relative to the adoption of the "Policy" as a water quality control plan and no one testified on this proposed action.

This Regional Board has received and considered written comments relative to this proposed action.

This Regional Board has announced its intent to hold a series of hearings to develop information necessary for the adoption of a "Water Quality Control Plan" for the Bay.

RESOLVED THAT THIS REGIONAL BOARD

Adopts Resolution No. 67-30 and the document entitled "Water Quality Control Policy, Tidal Waters Inland From the Golden Gate and Within the San Francisco Bay Region" as amended by the State Water Resources Control Board (Water Quality Control Board) in June 1967, as its water quality control plan pursuant to Section 13240 of the California Water Code.

States its intent to revise and republish this "Plan" pursuant to Paragraph XVI of Resolution No. 67-30 subsequent to the conclusion of the hearings on the need for revision of the "Plan."
