RESCINDING STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD ORDER NO. 70-6
"REQUIRING THE MILPITAS SANITARY DISTRICT TO CEASE AND DESIST
FROM DISCHARGING WASTES FROM ITS SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT
CONTRARY TO REQUIREMENTS PRESCRIBED BY THE CALIFORNIA REGIONAL
WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD, SAN FRANCISCO BAY REGION"

WHEREAS THIS REGIONAL BOARD HAS CONSIDERED

ADMINISTRATIVE INFORMATION

1. The State Water Resources Control Board initiated formal enforcement proceedings against Milpitas Sanitary District in Order 70-6 adopted on March 14, 1970.
2. On April 2, 1970 the State Water Resources Control Board remanded to the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region, continuing jurisdiction over all of the matters considered at its hearing in Martinez on March 14, 1970.

REGIONAL BOARD FINDINGS

Milpitas Sanitary District has demonstrated that the waste discharged from its treatment plant is in compliance with all requirements prescribed in Resolution No. 69-27.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE REGIONAL BOARD

The State Water Resource Control Board Order No. 70-6 is hereby rescinded.
