RESOLUTION NO. 70-82

AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 659 TO ADOPT A COMPLIANCE
TIME SCHEDULE FOR THE FAIRFIELD-SUISUN SEWER DISTRICT

WHEREAS THIS REGIONAL BOARD HAS CONSIDERED

INFORMATION ABOUT THIS DISCHARGE

1. This Regional Board adopted Resolution No. 659 prescribing waste discharge requirements for the Fairfield-Suisun Sewer District, called the discharger below, into Suisun Slough, on April 15, 1965.
2. The discharger's letter dated October 7, 1970 set forth a time schedule to correct the odor problems in ponds by removal of scum and weed growths by November 6, 1970.

RESOLVED BY THIS REGIONAL BOARD

1. Pursuant to Section 13263(c) of the California Water Code, this Regional Board adopts the following time schedule for compliance with the requirements of Resolution No. 659:

Complete improvements needed and demonstrate
compliance with the requirements of Resolution
No. 659 for prevention of odors by November 6, 1970.

2. The discharger is required to file a written progress report with this Regional Board pursuant to Section 13267 of the California Water Code by November 20, 1970.
3. This compliance time schedule is subject to revision in the discretion of this Regional Board.
4. If the discharger fails to comply with this schedule, the Executive Officer is instructed to bring a recommendation on the initiation of formal enforcement proceedings to the Regional Board for its consideration.
