ORDER NO. 71-1

AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 70-99 AND ADOPTING
A COMPLIANCE TIME SCHEDULE
FOR
STANDARD OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA
WESTERN OPERATIONS, INC.
RICHMOND, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region, finds that:

1. This Regional Board adopted Resolution No. 70-99 prescribing waste discharge requirements for the Standard Oil Company of California, Western Operations, Inc., called the discharger below, on December 22, 1970.
2. The discharger's letter dated December 29, 1970 set forth a schedule for complying with those waste discharge requirements.
3. The Board has notified the discharger and interested agencies and individuals of its intent to adopt a compliance time schedule for those waste discharge requirements.
4. The Board in a public meeting heard and considered all comments pertaining to this matter.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, the discharger shall comply with the following:

A. Time schedule for compliance with waste discharge requirements on:

1. MPN coliform in Waste "A" effluent:

Completion of preliminary design	March 1, 1971
Authorization for funding	April 1, 1971
Complete detailed design	August 1, 1971
Start of construction	September 15, 1971
50% completion of construction	March 15, 1972
Complete construction and place facilities in operation	June 1, 1972

2. Dissolved oxygen in the receiving waters and toxicity in Waste "A" effluent:

Start of construction	May 15, 1971
50% completion of construction	June 15, 1971
Completion of construction	July 15, 1971
Demonstrate compliance	August 15, 1971
