

RE-ISSUING RESOLUTION NO. 70-33, "ORDERING
CONTRA COSTA COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICT NO. 3
TO CEASE AND DESIST VIOLATIONS OF THE WASTE
DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS OF RESOLUTION NO. 70-26,
CONTRA COSTA COUNTY" TO SAN PABLO SANITARY
DISTRICT, AND AMENDING THE RE-ISSUED RESOLUTION

ORDER NO. 71-18

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region finds:

1. On March 26, 1970 this Regional Board adopted Resolution No. 70-33, "ORDERING CONTRA COSTA COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICT NO. 3 TO CEASE AND DESIST VIOLATIONS OF THE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS OF RESOLUTION NO. 70-26, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY", after conducting a public hearing into the matter of that District's violations of waste discharge requirements.
2. On October 1, 1970 annexation of Contra Costa County Sanitation District No. 3 to San Pablo Sanitary District was officially completed and operational responsibility was assumed by the Sanitary District.
3. On October 9, 1970 the San Pablo Sanitary District reported that delays caused by circumstances beyond its control necessitated revisions to the time schedule of Resolution No. 70-33, including a two-month delay in starting construction and demonstrating compliance with waste discharge requirements. The Sanitary District requested such modifications in the time schedule.
4. On March 25, 1971, in the East Bay Municipal Utility District's Board Room in Oakland, California, after due notice to the discharger and all other affected persons, the Regional Board conducted a public hearing at which the discharger appeared and evidence was received concerning re-issuing and amending the Order to Cease and Desist.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

1. Resolution No. 70-33 is re-issued to the San Pablo Sanitary District.
2. The time schedule of Resolution No. 70-33 is amended in part to read thus:

Award contracts for all needed facilities
on or before April 27, 1971

Begin construction of all needed
facilities on or before May 15, 1971

Complete construction of all needed
facilities on or before

November 15, 1971

Demonstrate compliance with all
requirements on or before

December 30, 1971

San Pablo Sanitary District is required to file with the Regional Board not more than 15 days after each of the above dates a report, under penalty of perjury, on progress toward compliance with this Order to Cease and Desist.
