ORDER NO. 71-23

AMENDING THE TIME SCHEDULE CONTAINED IN
RESOLUTION NO. 70-80 FOR COMPLIANCE WITH
THE REQUIREMENTS THEREIN BY VALLEJO SANITATION
AND FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT, SOLANO COUNTY

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region finds:

1. On October 22, 1970, this Regional Board adopted Resolution No. 70-80 to prescribe revised requirements for waste discharge by Vallejo Sanitation and Flood Control District into Carquinez Strait and onto land in Vallejo, after considering this matter and the testimony of the discharger and others at a public meeting.
2. Resolution No. 70-80 also established a partial time schedule for compliance with the revised requirements.
3. Resolution No. 70-80 also required Vallejo Sanitation and Flood Control District in conjunction with American Canyon County Water District, Napa Sanitation District, and the U. S. Navy, Mare Island Naval Shipyard to develop a coordinated subregional water quality control program consistent with the general concepts of Phase I of the plan recommended by the Final Bay-Delta Program Report and submit a progress report on the status of needed studies by December 1, 1970.
 - a. In implementing this, Vallejo Sanitation and Flood Control District, on behalf of all the above-named participants, filed a letter dated February 22, 1971 which submitted a schedule for the Lower Napa River Subregional Study; it called for completing the Final Engineering Report for the Subregional plan by October 1, 1971.
 - b. The Regional Board accepted that schedule by a Motion adopted during a regular meeting on March 25, 1971.
4. The discharger's letter dated March 12, 1971, pointed out that his compliance schedule is dependent upon the Lower Napa River Subregional plan, and requested the Regional Board to modify the compliance time schedule of Resolution No. 70-80 to conform with dates accepted on March 25, 1971, for completing that subregional study.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

1. The time schedule of Resolution No. 70-80 is amended in part to read thus:

Complete a master plan for recommended
improvements to permit compliance with
all requirements by October 1, 1971

Submit to Regional Board a time schedule
for major steps leading to the compliance
with all requirements by January 1, 1972

REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

The discharger is required to file written progress reports with this Regional Board pursuant to Section 13267 of the California Water Code within 15 days after each of the dates specified above.
