ORDER NO. 72-21

ORDER AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 70-81  
TO ADOPT A REVISED COMPLIANCE TIME SCHEDULE  
FOR  
EAST BAY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region, finds that:

1. The Regional Board on October 22, 1970, adopted Resolution 70-81 prescribing a compliance time schedule for East Bay Municipal Utility District for compliance with the requirements of Resolution No. 68-8.
2. The District proceeded on schedule with preliminary work, but was informed in July, 1971, that the project would have to be modified to conform to a new Environmental Protection Agency requirement for 85% BOD removal.
3. The project modifications have resulted in a delay which was beyond the control of the District.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT this Regional Board amends the compliance time schedule in its Resolution No. 70-81 to read

Complete Plans and Specifications for (3) Building Additions and Outfall Modifications	by May 1, 1973
Award Construction Contracts for item (3)	by September 15, 1973
Complete construction of:	
Item (1)	by July 1, 1974
Item (3)	by September 1, 1974
Item (2)	by February 15, 1975
Demonstrate compliance with all requirements	by September 1, 1975"
