ORDER NO. 72-45

RESCINDING ORDER NO. 71-9  
FOR  
PHILLIPS PETROLEUM COMPANY  
AVON REFINERY  
CONTRA COSTA COUNTY

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region, finds that:

- A. On February 25, 1971, Order No. 71-9, an Order to Cease and Desist violations of the requirements of Resolution No. 67-31 was issued to the Phillips Petroleum Company, Avon Refinery.
- B. Phillips Petroleum Company, as of September 1, 1971, has completed the installation of: (1) fourteen pond aerators, (2) a sulfide, ammonia and phenol stripper, (3) a modified crude oil desalting process, and (4) a domestic sewage chlorination facility. The company has eliminated its lube rerun and solvent treatment operations.
- C. Phillips Petroleum Company is in compliance with the discharge requirements specified in the cease and desist order and has complied with the provisions of that order.
- D. This Board at a public meeting on July 25, 1972, heard and considered all comments pertaining to this matter.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

This Board's Order No. 71-9 is rescinded.
