ORDER NO. 72-93

RESCINDING ORDER NO. 70-32
SAN PABLO SANITARY DISTRICT,
CONTRA COSTA COUNTY

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region, finds that:

- A. On March 26, 1970, Resolution No. 70-32, an Order to Cease and Desist from discharging wastes contrary to requirements prescribed in Resolution No. 70-27 was issued to the San Pablo Sanitary District.
- B. On February 1, 1972, the San Pablo Sanitary District completed construction of a new secondary treatment plant.
- C. The San Pablo Sanitary District is in compliance with the discharge requirements specified in the Cease and Desist Order and has complied with the provisions of that order.
- D. This Board at a public meeting on October 26, 1972, heard and considered all comments pertaining to this matter.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

This Board's Resolution No. 70-32 is rescinded.
