AN ORDER RESCINDING ORDER NO. 75-59

VIRGINIA CHEMICALS, INCORPORATED  
CROCKETT, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board finds that:

1. The Board, on September 16, 1975, adopted Order No. 75-59 prescribing waste discharge requirements for Virginia Chemicals, Inc., herein-after called the discharger, for the discharge of non-contact cooling water and process wastewater resulting from the production of liquid sulfur dioxide.
2. The discharger notified the Board in letters dated October 11, 1977, and June 20, 1978, that its Selby Plant near Crockett has been terminated and all discharge of wastewater has been eliminated. On August 11, 1978, an inspection by Regional Board staff verified that discharge of all wastewater has ceased.
3. The Board has notified the discharger and interested agencies and persons of its intent to rescind waste discharge requirements, and has provided them with an opportunity for a public hearing and an opportunity to submit their written views and recommendations.
4. The Board in a public meeting heard and considered all comments pertaining to the rescinding of waste discharge requirements.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT Regional Board Order No. 75-59, NPDES Permit No. CA0006211 is rescinded.
