ORDER NO. 79-104

NPDES NO. CA0037711

WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR:

CITY OF MILL VALLEY  
MARIN COUNTY

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region (hereinafter called the Board) finds that:

1. The City of Mill Valley (hereinafter called the discharger) has previously been issued permit by this Board under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) in Order No. 74-207.
2. The discharger has submitted application for reissuance of the NPDES permit.
3. The waste discharge remains as described in Order No. 74-207 and effluent and receiving water limitations remain appropriate to the discharge.
4. Order No. 74-207 prescribes certain tasks and a compliance time schedule for those tasks for facilities improvements needed to comply with the Basin Plan. These tasks and the compliance time schedule need to be revised to reflect current project status.
5. This project involves the continued operation of a publicly owned facility to provide sewerage service with negligible or no expansion of use beyond that previously existing. Consequently, this project will not have a significant effect on the environment based upon the exemption provided in Section 15101, Title 14, California Administrative Code.
6. The Board has notified the dischargers and interested agencies and persons of its intent to prescribe waste discharge requirements for the proposed discharges and has provided them with an opportunity for a public hearing and an opportunity to submit their written views and recommendations.
7. The Board, in a public meeting, heard and considered all comments pertaining to the discharges.
8. This Order shall serve to reissue National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permits pursuant to Section 402 of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act, or amendments thereto, and shall take effect at the end of ten days from the date of hearing provided the Regional Administrator, has no objections.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, pursuant to the provisions contained in Division 7 of the California Water Code and the Federal Clean Water Act and regulations and guidelines adopted thereunder that:

1. The NPDES permit as contained in Order No. 74-207 is hereby reissued with the following modifications:

Provision D.2.b.

The discharger shall comply with the following time schedule to assure compliance with Effluent Limitations A.1.a, A.1.c, A.6; Receiving Water Limitation B.2.d; and Discharge Prohibition C.1.

. Submit Step II grant application (with value engineering proposal) to SWRCB and this Board	by September 1, 1979
. Submit draft Engineering contract to SWRCB and this Board	by September 1, 1979
. Submit a Report of Waste Discharge in accordance with Resources Agency Guidelines	by September 17, 1979
c. Financing	
. Provide to this Board assurance of project financing, or a time schedule including necessary actions to obtain the needed financing	
. For Step II	by September 1, 1979
. For Step III	by June 1, 1980

Provision D.10

This Order expires on July 1, 1983, and the discharger must file a Report of Waste Discharge in accordance with Title 23, California Administrative Code, not later than 180 days in advance of such date as application for issuance of new waste discharge requirements.

2. All other terms and conditions contained in Order No. 74-207 and the existing monitoring and reporting requirements remain in full force and effect without modification.
