ORDER NO. 82-25

ORDER RESCINDING CEASE AND DESIST  
ORDER NO. 79-8 ISSUED TO THE  
CITY OF BENICIA,  
SOLANO COUNTY

1. On May 17, 1977 this Regional Board adopted Order No. 77-42 (NPDES NO. CA0038091) prescribing waste discharge requirements for discharge of wastewater into Carquinez Straits by the City of Benicia, Solano County.
2. On January 16, 1979, this Regional Board adopted Order No. 79-8, ordering the City of Benicia, Solano County, to cease and desist from discharging wastes contrary to the requirements specified in Order No. 77-42, and prescribing a compliance time schedule.
3. The City completed construction of new secondary treatment facilities by April 1981 and has achieved full and consistent compliance with all applicable discharge requirements prescribed in this Board's Order No. 77-42 and Cease and Desist Order No. 79-8. The City has effectively implemented a source control program, and has fully complied with provisions of the Cease and Desist Order.
4. On April 21, 1982 at a meeting starting at 9:30 a.m. in the Assembly Room, State Building, 1111 Jackson Street, Oakland, after due notice to the discharger and all other interested persons, the Regional Board conducted a public hearing at which the discharger appeared and evidence was received concerning the discharge.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT this Regional Board's Order No. 79-8 is rescinded.
