AN ORDER AMENDING ORDER NO. 81-20
WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR:

NATIONAL SEMICONDUCTOR CORPORATION
SANTA CLARA COUNTY

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region, (hereinafter called the Board) finds that:

1. On May 20, 1981 the Board adopted Order No. 81-20 prescribing waste discharge requirements for National Semiconductor Corporation.
2. The discharger presently discharges 350,000 gallons per day of reject water from a reverse osmosis water purification system. This waste is discharged to a storm drain tributary to Calabazas Creek and San Francisco Bay.
3. The discharger has requested a permit amendment to increase the average daily flow to one million gallons per day. The increase flow would not have any adverse impact on the environment, surface water or ground water.
4. The Board has notified the discharger and interested agencies and persons of its intent to amend waste discharge requirements for the discharge and has provided them with an opportunity for a public hearing and an opportunity to submit their written views and recommendations.
5. This project is exempt from the provisions of Chapter 3 (commencing with Section 21100) of Division 13 of the Public Resources Code (CEQA) pursuant to Section 13389 of the California Water Code.
6. The Board, in a public meeting, heard and considered all comments pertaining to the discharge.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT Order No. 81-20 is amended as follows:

1. Prohibition A.2 shall hereinafter read:

"The average daily flow shall not exceed 1,000,000 gallons per day."
