Project Description	<p>The purpose of this project is to repair the existing wood pilings to prevent failure.</p> <p>The project activities include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Repairing ten wooden piles;• Repairing one of the five piles in the rock rip rap area by hand to avoid work in an eelgrass patch;• Repairing the other four piles in the rock rip rap area using a fiberglass interlocking jacket with a marine epoxy at zero or minus tide to concentrate work to a small area and to avoid the eelgrass patch;• Sleeving the remaining five piles with 14-inch diameter epoxy coated steel piles;• Utilizing a spud barge and crane as the platform for pile driving/sleeving work;• Using vibratory hammer to minimize underwater noise impacts; and• Placing a containment boom around all active areas of the construction site. <p>No compensatory mitigation is proposed for this project.</p> <p>The City of Morro Bay filed a Categorical Exemption on June 28, 2016.</p>
