To be given full consideration, any comments or recommendations you may have concerning the enclosed documents must be submitted in writing to the Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) office by **noon on 30 April 2010**. Written materials submitted after **noon on 30 April 2010** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party. Please note that the tentative documents will receive internal legal and management review during the public comment period

A Public Hearing has been scheduled for the Regional Water Board to consider rescission of Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. 5-01-092 at its 26/27/28 May 2010 Board Meeting.

The Notice of Public Hearing and a copy of a Proof of Posting form are also enclosed. By **31 March 2010** post one (1) copy of the Notice at:

- The nearest city hall or county courthouse;
- The post office nearest to the Facility (if allowed), and
- At the public entrance of the Facility.

Proof of posting, using the enclosed form, shall be filed with this office by **7 April 2010**.
