TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed are tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) for Golden State Vintners, Cutler Winery at 38558 Road 128 in Tulare County. To be given full consideration, any comments or recommendations you may have regarding the tentative WDRs must be submitted in writing to the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) office in Fresno by **5:00 pm on 26 December 2014**. Absent a showing of good cause and lack of prejudice to other parties, the Board Chair may exclude comments and evidence received after this deadline.
