NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING: The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) is scheduled to hold a public hearing to consider adoption of Tentative Order No. R9-2013-0001, An Order Amending Order No. R9-2013-0001

NPDES, No. CAS010266, National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit and Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges from the Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4) Draining the Watersheds within the San Diego Region (Tentative Order). The Tentative Order proposes to amend Order No. R9-2013-0001, the Regional MS4 Permit, to address a variety of issues including coverage for Copermitttees in Orange County Flood Control District, and the cities of Aliso Viejo, Dana Point, Laguna Beach, Laguna Hills, Laguna Niguel, Laguna Woods, Mission Viejo, Rancho Santa Margarita, San Clemente, and San Juan Capistrano, and incorporation of limited permit provisions applicable to the City of Lake Forest. If adopted, the Tentative Order will supersede the Orange County Copermitttees' current Fourth Term MS4 Permit, Order No. R9-2009-0002. The public hearing on this matter will be held during the San Diego Water Board meeting scheduled for February 11, 2015 in the Council Chambers of the City of Mission Viejo, located at 260 Civic Center, Mission Viejo, CA 92681. The item will be heard during the

meeting that starts at 9:00 A.M. Oral testimony will be limited in time by the Board Chair.
