**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT AND PUBLIC HEARING
FOR
RESCISSION OF DISCHARGE PERMIT**

**San Francisco Public Utilities Commission
Pulgas Dechloramination Facility
66 Cañada Road, Redwood City, San Mateo County**

Board staff proposes to rescind a permit issued in accordance with the Clean Water Act and Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act. This permit regulates discharges from the above discharger's Pulgas facility to Crystal Springs Reservoir. The rescission would be effective upon the discharger obtaining coverage for the same discharges under a 2014 statewide general permit by the State Water Resources Control Board.

The deadline for receipt of comment on the draft rescission order is 5:00 p.m. on September 21, 2015. Comments must be sent to the **attention of Marcia Liao**. Persons wishing to file written comments on any aspect of this matter must do so no later than this deadline so that such comments may be considered.

The Board will consider adopting the draft rescission during a meeting to commence at 9:00 a.m. on **October 14, 2015**, in the Auditorium at 1515 Clay Street, Oakland. Interested persons are invited to express their views at this hearing.

Pursuant to California Code of Regulations Title 23 section 2050(c), any party who challenges the Board's action through a petition to the State Water Resources Control Board under Water Code section 13320 will be limited to raising only those substantive issues that were raised before the Board at the hearing or in timely submitted correspondence.
