Three petitions for reconsideration of Decision 1486, which approved Applications 24578 and 24579 and authorized the issuance of permits therefore, have been filed. These petitions are on behalf of the following:

- Interested party Santa Ynez River Water Conservation District (SYRWCD);
- Protestant Cachuma Conservation Release Board; and
 - Protestant United States Bureau of Reclamation.

Although the applicant Santa Ynez River Water Conservation District, Emproyement District No. 1, did not file a separate petition for reconsideration, the SYRWCD indicates that the applicant joins in the petition submitted on behalf of the SYRWCD.

- 1. The petitions raise substantial issues which provide a basis for reconsideration as set forth in Section 737.1, Title 23, California Administrative Code.
- 2. The petitions for reconsideration should be granted on the ground that substantial issues are raised.
- 3. This order to grant reconsideration does not imply any decision of the Board on the merits of the issues raised. It is solely a decision that the issues raised are sufficiently substantial to merit fuller consideration.

- 2. Applicant, protestants, and interested parties shall, prior to the Board's taking final action, be notified of the scope of reconsideration as provided in Section 737.4, Title 23, California Administrative Code.
