Nevada County Sanitation District No. 1 (NCSD) has filed a wastewater change petition with the State Water Resources Control Board pursuant to Water Code section 1211. NCSD currently discharges water treatment plant effluent to Gas Canyon Creek. The petition seeks authorization to discharge its water treatment plant effluent into a land-based leachfield system and associated infrastructure and eliminate discharge of effluent to Gas Canyon Creek.
