

Chris C. Mahannah, P.E.	Chris C. Mahannah is a registered Professional Engineer, a Nevada licensed Water Right Surveyor, and a principal of Mahannah & Associates, LLC. Mr. Mahannah may testify regarding the availability of unappropriated water for Applications 31487 and 31488. He may also testify regarding the municipal dedication rates and the consumptive use component for the proposed storage of water rights under the Petitions for Change and their operation under Truckee River Operating Agreement (TROA), the potential injury to other legal water users, and conditions that should be imposed on the Applications and Petitions for Change, if approved.	20 min. Willem A. Schreuder, PhD.	Dr. Schreuder is a principal at Principia Mathematica, Inc. Dr. Schreuder may testify related to his review of the Truckee River Operating Model (TROM) and its use related to the TROA Final Environmental Impact Statement / Environmental Report, including limitations and impacts related to development of TROA and the operation of the subject of Applications and Petitions for Change.	20 Min. Kenneth Knox, PE, PhD.	Dr. Knox is a Principal Water Resources Engineer/Project Manager at URS Corporation. Dr. Knox may testify related to the water rights, permits, and other regulatory agency actions and documents relevant to water supply and management in the Truckee-Carson River Basin, and how these relate to TROA and the operation under the Proposed Applications and Petitions for Change. He may testify related to beneficial use of the water, potential injury to other legal water users from the operation of the Petitions and Applications under TROA, and conditions that should be imposed on the Applications and Petitions, if approved. He may testify related to the proposed beneficial use of the water under TROA and impacts to the public interest and public trust.	20 Min.	Yes
Lyman F. McConnell	Mr. McConnell was the TCID Project Manager from November 1, 1984 until March 1, 2006. As Project Manager, his responsibilities included records administration for TCID. In this capacity, he is familiar with the records kept by TCID, including historical records of matters occurring before he became Project Manager. Mr. McConnell may testify regarding the operation and management of the Newlands Project, the historic utilization by TCID of water stored in the upstream reservoirs in California. He may testify regarding litigation on the Truckee River and the settlements and compromises of the parties with interests in water in the Truckee River and its tributaries leading to the Truckee River Agreement and the <i>Orr Ditch</i> Decree.	20 Min. Mr. Schank may also testify regarding the benefits to the public interest and public trust, including benefits to the Newlands project, from the current and historic management system for the operation of the California reservoirs.
