Notice of Minor Change to Water Right Application A030794

The State Water Resources Control Board has initiated a minor change under Water Code section 1700.4, seeking to make changes to pending water right application A030794. The project associated with the application and minor change is in Mendocino County and would divert water from the Navarro River stream system.

Summary of Water Right Application A030794

Date of Filing: The application was filed with the State Water Board on October 13, 1998.

Source of Water: The source of water is an Unnamed Stream, which is tributary to Donelly Creek thence Anderson Creek thence the Navarro River.

Amount: The maximum amount of water requested for diversion is 5.9 acre-feet per year.

Season of Diversion: The season for diversion of water is from December 15 of each year through March 31 of the succeeding year.

Point of Diversion: The point where water will be diverted is located at North 2,140,343 feet and East 6,178,722 feet by California Coordinate System, Zone 2, North American Datum 1983, within the Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 36, Township 14 North, Range 14 West, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Purpose of Use: The purposes of use for water are irrigation, domestic, dust control, and fire protection.

Place of Use: The place of use for water is 27 acres within Section 36, Township 14 North, Range 14 West, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Summary of Minor Change

Source of Water: The source of water has not changed.

Season of Diversion: The season for diversion of water has not changed.

Amount: The maximum amount of water requested for diversion has not changed.

Point of Diversion: The point where water will be diverted has not changed.
