Dear Ms. Irvin:


I own a trucking company, Dalton Trucking, Inc. We employ 350 employees in Fontana, California.

We support the draft General Industrial Storm Water Permit as proposed because it provides a rational, cost-effective approach for businesses like mine to protect water supplies.

We understand, however, that some have asked for amendments requiring numeric limits for storm water discharges. Such an approach violates state and federal guidelines for storm water management, would be ineffective because of the nature of storm water and would cost companies like mine thousands of dollars.
