RESOLUTION NO. 75-41

EXTENDING THE STUDY AND ACTIVITIES BETWEEN THE  
STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD, THE  
DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, AND THE DEPARTMENT OF  
FISH AND GAME FOR LABORATORY CERTIFICATION

WHEREAS:

1. The Board has continued need for assistance in evaluating the chemical, bacteriological, and fish bioassay laboratories of self-monitoring dischargers and wastewater laboratories and the results of their analyses in accordance with federal requirements.
2. The Department of Health and the Department of Fish and Game have for the Fiscal Years of 1973/74 and 1974/75 been engaged in this study and activity.
3. The Department of Health and the Department of Fish and Game are capable of and amenable to providing expert assistance during F. Y. 1975/76.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board's Executive Officer, or any person delegated by the Executive Officer, be authorized to execute Agreements between the State Water Resources Control Board and the Department of Health and the Department of Fish and Game for personnel services of individuals acceptable to the Board during the period of July 1, 1975, through June 30, 1976, at a cost not to exceed \$130,000 for the Department of Health and \$38,166 for the Department of Fish and Game to continue the Laboratory Certification Project.
