STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 76-19

REVIEW OF ACTION OF THE CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD, NORTH COAST REGION, REGARDING AN OIL SPILL TO BAECHTEL CREEK INVOLVING ALLYN TRANSPORTATION COMPANY, PHILLIPS PETROLEUM COMPANY, AND CHARLES PERSICO.

WHEREAS:

- 1. On February 26, 1976, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, North Coast Region (Regional Board), conducted a hearing regarding an oil spill to Baechtel Creek allegedly involving Allyn Transportation Company, Phillips Petroleum Company, and Charles Persico which occurred on December 12, 1975.
- 2. After hearing, the Regional Board declined to refer the matter of said oil spill to the Attorney General for action.
- 3. After consideration of the circumstances surrounding the aforementioned oil spill, it appears to the State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) that the failure of the Regional Board to refer the aforementioned matter to the Attorney General should be reviewed by the State Board.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board will review, on its own motion, the failure of the Regional Board to refer the aforementioned matter to the Attorney General.
