RESOLUTION NO. 76-73

AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF A
CONTRACT WITH RESOURCE MANAGEMENT ASSOCIATES
FOR REVIEW AND EVALUATION OF REPORTS FOR THE
CITY OF SAN DIEGO POINT LOMA WASTEWATER
OUTFALL MONITORING PROGRAM

WHEREAS:

1. The State Board's Water Quality Control Plan for Ocean Waters of California requires dischargers to conduct self-monitoring programs to ensure protection of the marine environment.
2. The City of San Diego has been conducting a monitoring program at the Point Loma wastewater outfall since 1962 which has been reviewed by the City, the Regional Board, and their consultant through 1974.
3. The analysis proposed will be performed on data and information accumulated at the same site during the period January 1975 to April 1976.
4. The contractor will train the Board's staff to conduct the various analyses that are performed with the intent that these analyses will be performed by Board staff in the future.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Executive Officer be authorized to negotiate and execute a contract with Resource Management Associates for review and evaluation of reports for the City of San Diego Point Loma wastewater outfall monitoring program for a duration of six months in an amount not to exceed \$15,000.
