RESOLUTION NO. 76-96

AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE CONTRACTOR'S REPORT ON PHASE I OF THE SANTA MARIA VALLEY PILOT GROUNDWATER QUALITY CONTROL PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO SUBMIT A PROPOSAL TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR PHASE II

WHEREAS:

1. On March 27, 1974, the Environmental Protection Agency entered into a contract with the State Water Resources Control Board under which the State Board was to conduct Phase I of the Santa Maria Valley Pilot Groundwater Quality Control Project at a cost of \$59,506.
2. On May 10, 1974, the State Board entered into Standard Agreement No. 3-2-58 in the amount of \$59,506 with the firm of Brown and Caldwell to carry out the studies required under Phase I of the Santa Maria Valley Pilot Groundwater Quality Control Project.
3. Brown and Caldwell has completed the work required by the contract and submitted a final report on the study.
4. The State Board and the Environmental Protection Agency find it desirable to continue into Phase II of the Santa Maria Valley Pilot Groundwater Quality Control Project.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. The final report entitled "Development of a Nonpoint Source Pollution Control Program for Santa Maria Valley, California" is accepted in fulfillment of Standard Agreement No. 3-2-58 with Brown and Caldwell.
2. The Executive Officer is authorized to transmit copies of the report to the Environmental Protection Agency in fulfillment of the contract between the Environmental Protection Agency and the State Board for conducting Phase I of the study.
3. The Executive Officer is authorized to submit a proposal to the Environmental Protection Agency for funds to conduct Phase II of the Santa Maria Valley Pilot Groundwater Quality Control Project, and to negotiate and accept a grant.
