## STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 77-53

RESOLUTION REGARDING REQUEST FOR GRANT FUNDING OF PART OF A TRANS-MISSION PIPELINE LOCATED ON A PRIVATE GOLF COURSE, CITY OF YOUNT-VILLE, PROJECT NO. C-06-0979.

## WHEREAS:

- 1. An informal meeting was held on May 25, 1977, W. Don Maughan presiding, with representatives from the City of Yountville and the Division of Water Quality.
- 2. The purpose of said meeting was to discuss a staff denial of grant funding of a 1,400 foot section of a transmission pipeline to be located in an easement owned by the City on a privately owned golf course.
- 3. Section 2102(x) of the State Board Clean Water Grant Regulations (Subchapter 7, Chapter 3, Title 23, California Administrative Code) defines "outfall" or "outfall sewer" as a line which extends up the point of use.
- 4. The staff of the Division of Water Quality has interpreted the above-stated regulation to allow grant funding only to the boundary line of the property on which the transported effluent is to be used.
- 5. The State Board concurs in this interpretation, and further, deems the burden of this expense to be more appropriately absorbed at the local level.
- 6. The above-stated interpretation is consistent with the grant regulations adopted on February 24, 1977, and the regulations adopted on May 19, 1977.
- 7. Due to the financial status of the grantee and the costs involved in construction of this segment of the pipeline, good cause does not exist for the State Board to exercise its authority under Section 2152 of the Clean Water Grant Regulations.

## THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. The request for grant funding of said section of the transmission pipeline is denied.
- 2. A waiver pursuant to Section 2152 is denied.
