## STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 77-65

EXTENDING THE STUDY AND ACTIVITIES BETWEEN THE STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD, THE DEPART-MENT OF HEALTH, AND THE DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME FOR LABORATORY CERTIFICATION

## WHEREAS:

- 1. The Board has continued need for assistance in evaluating the chemical, bacteriological, and fish bioassay laboratories of self-monitoring dischargers, and wastewater laboratories and the results of their analyses in accordance with Federal requirements;
- 2. The Department of Health and the Department of Fish and Game have since Fiscal Year 1973-74 been engaged in this study and activity;
- 3. The Department of Health and the Department of Fish and Game are capable of and amenable to providing expert assistance during Fiscal Year 1977-78.

## THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board's Executive Director be authorized to execute Agreement between the State Water Resources Control Board and the Department of Health and the Department of Fish and Game for personnel services of individuals acceptable to the Board during the period of July 1, 1977, through June 30, 1978, at a cost not to exceed \$163,412 for the Department of Health and \$44,900 for the Department of Fish and Game to continue the Laboratory Certification Program.
