RESOLUTION NO. 77-84

APPROVING ORDER NO. 77-124 OF THE NORTH COAST
REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD AMENDING THE
WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLAN, NORTH COAST BASIN (1B)

WHEREAS:

- As this amendment*
1. At its June 23, 1977, meeting, the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board adopted an amendment to the Water Quality Control Plan, North Coast Basin (1B), which prohibits the discharge of waste from new individual waste disposal systems subsequent to State Board approval of the amendment, and prohibits the discharge of waste from existing systems after July 1, 1982, within specified portions of the community of Geyserville, Sonoma County;
 2. Adoption of Order No. 77-124 by the Regional Board is based on consideration of the report of the Sonoma County Public Health Officer, including a survey of the adequacy of existing subsurface disposal systems, and an EIR prepared by Sonoma County for a project to construct a community wastewater treatment and collection system; and
 3. These prohibitions are reasonable and necessary in light of the evidence of a serious health hazard resulting from the use of individual disposal systems in the area.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board approves Order No. 77-124 of the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board which amends the Water Quality Control Plan, North Coast Basin (1B).
