BOARD ACCEPTANCE OF THE REPORTS SAN JOAQUIN VALLEY INTERAGENCY DRAINAGE PROGRAM - SUMMARY OF ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT (PHASE 1)
BY ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT PLANNING CORPORATION AND ASSESSMENT OF WATER QUALITY IMPACTS: ALTERNATIVES FOR MANAGEMENT OF SAN JOAQUIN VALLEY AGRICULTURAL DRAINAGE BY HYDROSCIENCE, INCORPORATED, AND AUTHORIZATION OF FINAL PAYMENTS

WHEREAS:

- 1. The Board is participating with the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation and the Department of Water Resources in the San Joaquin Valley Interagency Drainage Program.
- 2. The Board's responsibility in this program is to prepare an environmental assessment of various agricultural drainage management and disposal options and an environmental impact report of the recommended program.
- 3. The Board contracted with Hydroscience, Incorporated, to perform mathematical modeling of selected agricultural drainage management and disposal options.
- 4. The Board contracted with Environmental Impact Planning Corporation to conduct the preliminary assessment and screening of 13 agricultural drainage management and disposal options.
- 5. Both firms have completed their work in substantial fulfillment of their contractual obligations with the Board.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board accepts the final reports in fulfillment of Standard Agreements No. W6-088-41 and No. W6-086-41 with Hydroscience, Incorporated, and Environmental Impact Planning Corporation and authorizes final payments to the two consulting firms.
