STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 78-28

APPROVAL TO AMEND THE THREE AGENCY COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT FOR THE SAN JOAQUIN VALLEY INTERAGENCY DRAINAGE PROGRAM

WHEREAS:

- 1. The Cooperative Agreement among the State Water Resources Control Board, the State Department of Water Resources, and the United States Bureau of Reclamation supporting the San Joaquin Valley Interagency Drainage Program expires on September 30, 1978.
- 2. The Policy Group, with Mr. Maughan representing the State Water Resources Control Board, decided to extend the date for submission of the final program report to March 31, 1979.
- 3. Unforeseen details may remain to be completed after the final report submission deadline.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Chairman of the State Water Resources Control Board be authorized to execute, on behalf of the State Board, an amendment to the existing agreement among the State Department of Water Resources, the United States Bureau of Reclamation and the State Water Resources Control Board to extend the program until June 30, 1979, at a State Board cost not to exceed \$19,400.
