

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD  
RESOLUTION NO. 78-46  
AUTHORIZING FUNDING OF THE LOCAL SHARE OF A STEP 1 PROJECT  
FOR A PILOT STUDY OF SEPTAGE TREATMENT BASINS

WHEREAS:


1. The State Board's Clean Water Grant Program has funded nineteen countywide Step 1 Grant studies of management of anaerobic septic tank wastes (septage) which are currently underway.
2. Additional information on design parameters and performance of lagoons to treat septage is needed before concept approval and before detailed designs can be evaluated by the design review staff.
3. The progress of the many countywide studies is such that this information is needed within a few months.
4. All counties conducting such studies would benefit from the information to be derived from the proposed pilot study.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

The Division of Water Quality is authorized to enter into a new State Grant Contract or augment an existing State Grant Contract in an amount necessary to fund the local share of the costs of a pilot study of septage treatment lagoons.
