RESOLUTION NO. 78- 72

REAFFIRMATION OF THE DEDESIGNATION OF THE TAHOE REGIONAL PLANNING
AGENCY AS A 208 PLANNING AGENCY (STATE BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 78-39)

WHEREAS:


1. At its July 20, 1978, meeting, the State Board rejected certification/adoption of the Lake Tahoe 208 plan and dedesignated the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency (TRPA) as a 208 planning agency effective November 1, 1978 (Resolution No. 78-39);
2. Resolution No. 78-39 provided that, prior to November 1, 1978, the State Board could reconsider the dedesignation action in light of any significant new developments in the California/Nevada bi-state compact negotiations; and
3. Progress has been made in development of a new bi-state compact, including a reconstitution of TRPA; there remains, however, considerable uncertainty as to the eventual outcome.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the State Board reaffirms its decision to dedesignate TRPA as a 208 planning agency as set forth in State Board Resolution No. 78-39.
