STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 80-65

AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF AN UMBRELLA COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD AND THE U.S. GEOLOGICAL SURVEY TO CONTINUE A PROGRAM OF SPECIAL WATER QUALITY MONITORING STUDIES.

WHEREAS:

- 1. The State Board has implemented a program of special water quality monitoring studies, under an umbrella agreement, in cooperation with the U.S. Geological Survey.
- 2. The program includes monitoring for pesticides in certain streams, lake surveys, inventories of groundwater quality monitoring networks and water quality assessments of certain watersheds.
- 3. The proposed program would also include Lake Tahoe monitoring for 1981-82 and design of groundwater monitoring networks using completed inventories.
- 4. The U.S. Geological Survey has indicated its capability to perform such services and a desire to continue a cooperative program with the State Board for special water quality studies.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board's Executive Director be authorized to negotiate and execute a Cooperative Agreement with the U.S. Geological Survey for special water quality monitoring studies in an amount not to exceed \$80,000 in F.Y. 1980-81 Bond Fund monies and \$167,000 in F.Y. 1981-82 Bond Fund monies, subject to approval of the proposed F.Y. 1981-82 budget, for the period ending September 30, 1982.
