STATE FISCAL YEAR 1980-81 FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 1981

WHEREAS:

- 1. The State Water Resources Control Board is applying to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Region IX, for a Water Pollution Program Grant for Federal Fiscal Year 1981;
- The Section 106, Grant for Water Pollution Control Programs assists the State Board in financing the implementation and maintenance of adequate measures for prevention and abatement of water pollution, surveillance and enforcement, technical assistance, certification and operator training; and
- 3. In order to receive federal funds, the State Board will develop and implement a workplan.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. That the State Board authorizes the Executive Director to accept federal grant funds; and
- 2. That the Executive Director of the State Board and Executive Officers of the Regional Water Quality Control Boards are directed to implement and maintain the water pollution control programs described in the workplan and funded by the Fiscal Year 1981 106 Grant.
