STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 80-78

APPROVAL OF AMENDMENTS TO THE WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLAN FOR THE CENTRAL VALLEY REGION AND CERTIFICATION OF A PORTION OF THE STATE'S WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

WHEREAS:

- The State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) is responsible for preparing a Water Quality Management Plan pursuant to Section 208 of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act, and for approving Water Quality Control Plans (Basin Plans) and plan amendments adopted by the Regional Water Quality Control Boards pursuant to the Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act.
- 2. As part of Phase I 208 planning, the Counties of Plumas and Placer developed best management practices (BMPs) for one or more of the following: (a) erosion control and (b) onsite wastewater disposal systems.
- In July 1980, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region (Regional Board), held a public hearing on proposed Basin Plan amendments and adopted Resolution No. 80-111 (copy attached).
- 4. The State Board has reviewed the proposed amendments to the Basin Plan.
- The Counties of Plumas and Placer have each satisfactorily completed the provisions of their contracts.
- Local governmental agencies have taken necessary actions to implement the BMPs developed in each respective study.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board:

1. Approves Resolution No. 80-111 of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board amending the Water Quality Control Plan, Central Valley Region (Basin 5A).
