STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 80-79

ACCEPTANCE OF REPORTS FROM KERN AND KINGS COUNTIES

WHEREAS:

- The State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) is responsible for preparing a Water Quality Management Plan pursuant to Section 208 of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act, and for approving Water Quality Control Plans (Basin Plans) and plan amendments adopted by the Regional Water Quality Control Boards pursuant to the Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act.
- 2. As part of Phase I 208 planning, the State Board contracted with the Kern County Water Agency to develop a model for analyzing groundwater quality in Kern County.
- 3. As part of Phase I 208 planning, the State Board contracted with the Kings River Conservation District to complete a study of potential groundwater recharge areas.
- On July 25, 1980, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region (Regional Board), adopted Resolution No. 80-112 accepting reports prepared by the Kern County Water Agency and the Kings River Conservation District.
- 5. The State Board has reviewed the reports and contractual requirements.
- BMP or action plan development were not required as part of the contract.
- The reports satisfy the conditions of the respective contracts.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board approves Resolution No. 80-112 of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board accepting the final reports for the Kern County Water Agency and the Kings River Conservation District.
