STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 83-62

CONSIDERATION OF AN AMENDMENT TO THE WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLAN FOR THE SOUTH LAHONTAN BASIN INCORPORATING SPECIFIC EROSION CONTROL GUIDELINES FOR THE MAMMOTH CREEK WATERSHED, MONO COUNTY

WHEREAS:

- 1. The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Lahontan Region, (Regional Board) adopted the Water Quality Control Plan for the South Lahontan Basin (basin plan) on May 8, 1975.
- Division 7 of the California Water Code requires that basin plans shall be periodically reviewed and may be revised.
- 3. The basin plan contains general erosion control guidelines for the entire South Lahontan Basin.
- 4. Regional Board staff prepared a staff report which details the need for specific erosion control guidelines to protect the existing high quality of Mammoth and Hot Creeks and their present and future beneficial uses.
- 5. Regional Board staff conducted a workshop on March 16, 1983 at which no adverse comments were received.
- 6. On June 9, 1983, after a public hearing, the Regional Board adopted Resolution No. 83-5, Adopting an Amendment to the Water Quality Control Plan for the South Lahontan Basin Incorporating Specific Erosion Control Guidelines for the Mammoth Creek Watershed, Mono County.
- 7. On June 30, 1983, the Regional Board submitted a request for State Board consideration of approval for Resolution No. 83-5 in accordance with Section 13245 of the California Water Code.
- 8. A review of the record shows that sufficient justification for the erosion control guidelines contained in Resolution No. 83-5 has been provided and that the resolution is reasonable and consistent with federal and state statutes.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That Chapter 5, Implementation Plan, of the Water Quality Control Plan for the South Lahontan Basin be amended as described in Regional Board Resolution No. 83-5

and attachment entitled "Guidelines for Erosion Control in the Mammoth Creek Watershed".
