CERTIFYING THE BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICES DEVELOPED BY THE  
LOST HILLS WATER DISTRICT TO MANAGE PERCHED SALINE WATER

WHEREAS:


1. The U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) awarded the State Board \$400,000 as part of the State's Phase IV 208 grant to conduct studies in the Tulare Lake Basin.
2. The Tulare Lake Basin Project included studies conducted by the Lost Hills Water District.
3. The Lost Hills Water District produced a final report, "Salt Management Project in Lost Hills Water District", that identified BMPs for controlling perched saline drainage water.
4. The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region, reviewed and approved the report at their December 9, 1983 Board meeting.
5. The State Board has reviewed and considered the report.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the State Board approves the Lost Hills Water District's final report, "Salt Management Project in Lost Hills Water District", as completing requirements of their contract.
2. Certifies the BMPs contained in the report as part of the State's 208 Areawide Wastewater Treatment Management Plan.
3. Directs staff to transmit the final report to EPA requesting their review and approval.
