STATE WATER RESCOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 84-21

AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF CONTRACTS FOR A HYDROLOGIC STUDY OF THE GROUND WATER BASINS IN THE SAN DIEGO REGION

WHEREAS:

- 1. There is currently a lack of valid data on ground water conditions in the San Diego region.
- 2. The lack of valid data has caused conflicts between the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region's (Regional Board) policies of protecting water quality and proponents of water reclamation projects
- 3. It is essential that the Regional Board have valid, up-to-date information on ground water conditions to up date water quality objectives and to establish policies that protect water quality and, at the same time, allow the use of reclaimed water where appropriate.
- 4. A series of contracts with the Department of Water Resources and the U. S. Geologic Survey are being proposed for the purpose of conducting a four-year study of individual ground water basins in the San Diego region.
- 5. The results of the hydrologic study of the region's ground water basins will be useful to the Regional Board in updating ground water standards with strong emphasis placed on enhancing opportunities for reuse of reclaimed water.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. That the Executive Director or his designee be authorized to negotiate and execute contracts for a hydrologic study of the ground water basins in the San Diego region in an amount not to exceed \$720,000.
- 2. That funding of these contracts is limited to \$200,000 in F. Y. 1983-84, and subsequent years's funding is subject to availability of funds for this purpose.
