RESOLUTION NO. 84-38

APPROVING NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR DIVERSION OF WATER UNDER  
WATER RIGHT APPLICATION 25727 OF NATOMAS CENTRAL MUTUAL WATER COMPANY

WHEREAS:

1. The applicant proposes to divert up to 168 cubic feet per second, through existing facilities, from the Sacramento River, Natomas Cross Canal, and Reclamation District 1000 Main Drain, East Drain, and West Drain during the period from October 1 of each year to April 1 of the succeeding year for irrigation purposes. The maximum amount of water to be diverted will not exceed 10,000 acre-feet per annum.
2. Applicant has filed Application 25727 to appropriate water from the sources listed in No. 1 above.
3. The Board as lead agency has prepared a Negative Declaration for the applicant's project.
4. The Negative Declaration was circulated for public review in accordance with Title 23 of the California Administrative Code, Sections 15072 and 15073.
5. The Board has considered the proposed Negative Declaration and the initial study.
6. Based on the initial study and the proposed Negative Declaration, the Board finds that there is no substantial evidence that the project will have a significant effect on the environment.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The State Water Resources Control Board approves the Negative Declaration.
